

FLEXIBLE INSTRUCTION DAY EXPECTATIONS OVERVIEW

This document is intended as an overview of expectations for Flexible Instruction Days (FID). Additional information will be provided by each building's administrators. Questions should be directed to your child's teacher and/or building administration.

ELEMENTARY STUDENTS (GRADES K-6)	
HOW/WHAT WORK WILL BE COMPLETED?	HOW IS ATTENDANCE DETERMINED?
Students received FID/Snow Day packets to be kept at home. Students should complete this work when a Flexible Instruction Day is announced.	Students must complete packet work at home and return it the day following the FID. Students that return completed packets on the following day will be marked present for the FID. If a completed packet is not returned, student will be marked absent for the FID.

JR HIGH STUDENTS (GRADES 7-8)	
HOW/WHAT WORK WILL BE COMPLETED?	HOW IS ATTENDANCE DETERMINED?
Students received FID/Snow Day packets to be kept at home. Students should complete this work when a Flexible Instruction Day is announced.	Students must complete packet work at home and return it the day following the FID. Students that return completed packets on the following day will be marked present for the FID. If a completed packet is not returned, student will be marked absent for the FID.

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS (GRADES 9-12)	
HOW/WHAT WORK WILL BE COMPLETED?	HOW IS ATTENDANCE DETERMINED?
Our high school students take their Chromebooks home and will be expected to log in to their classes during the day to participate in Google classroom sessions.	Attendance for these days will be taken by 3pm on the actual FID day, based on whether the student completed their work in each class. If the work is completed and submitted your child will be marked as present. If the work is not completed and not submitted by 3pm your child will be marked absent.
