IMPORTANT NOTE: Bishop Verot's community service requirement (total of 100 hours) will also satisfy the Bright Futures requirement. Transfer students will need to make sure they have satisfied the Bright Futures requirement (100 hours for Academic or 75 hours for Medallion).

Reminder: Schedule change policy

- **One** and only **one** schedule change
- Has to be something from your alternates
- Drop/Add = first 3 days of the semester

DUAL ENROLLMENT (DE)

- You can take up to 2 classes per semester- total of 24 credits before you graduate BV. You can NOT earn your AA degree.
- DE classes count as both a college class AND a high school credit
- You have the option of taking a study hall, providing you with dedicated time to work on your online DE class
- A variety of courses are available to you: English, Math, Science, History, and Humanities
- Enrollment at USF is on a first come, first serve basis, so be sure to apply early to secure your spot
- All classes are online

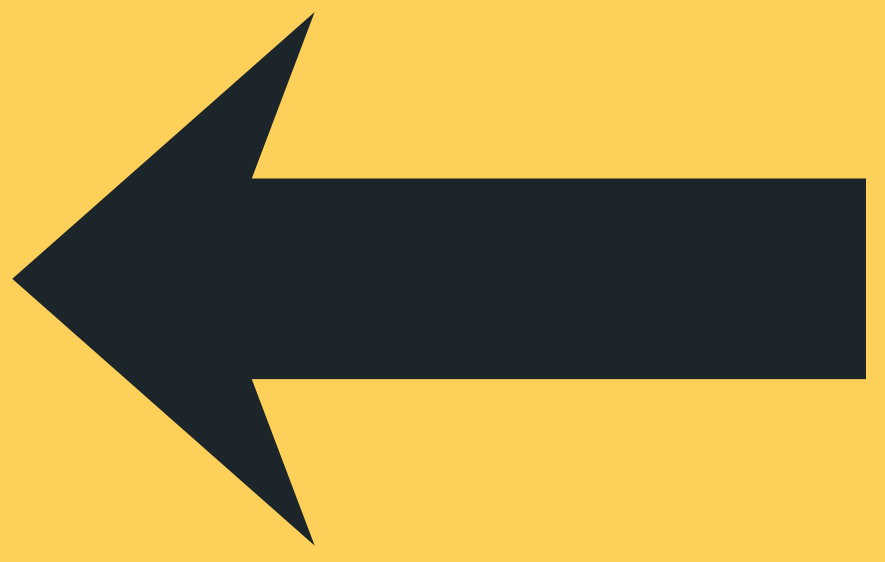



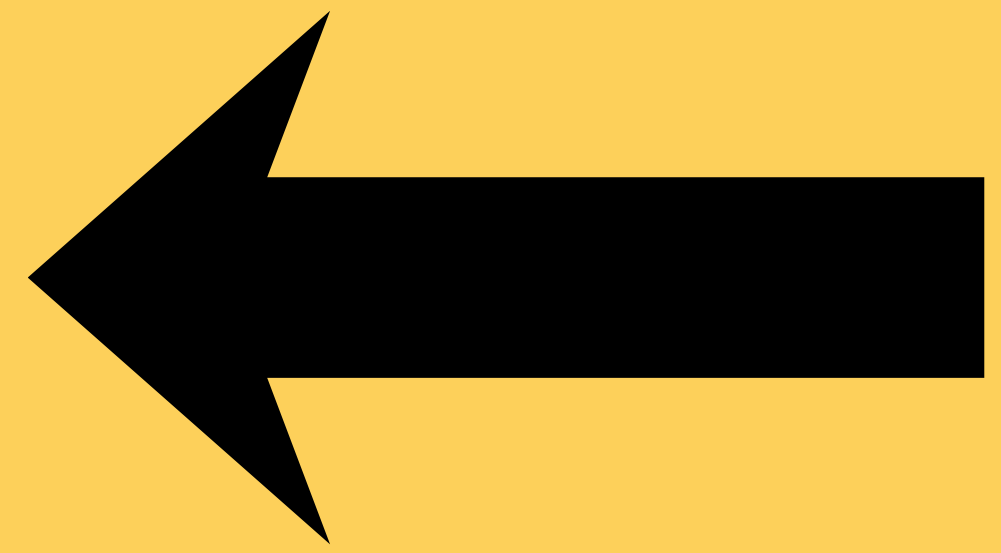
