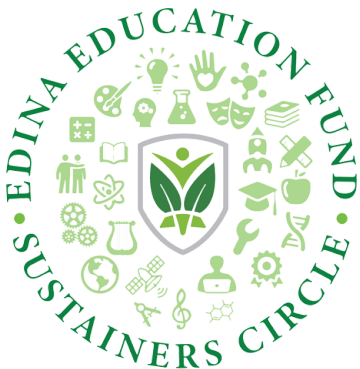
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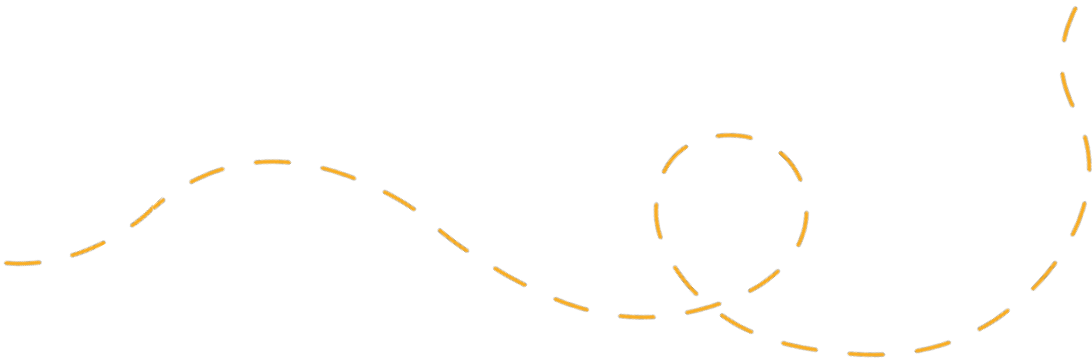


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Summer Learning, Year-Round Passion





As students hustle into class, fourth grade teacher, Roxanne May, welcomes her French immersion students. She has been with the district for 12 years, but looks forward to the change of pace that teaching enrichment classes every summer offers. “I absolutely love getting to spend meaningful, low-pressure time with kids outside the traditional school setting,” May shares. “Summer gives us room to be creative, silly, hands-on, and curious together.”

May is a part of the Bonjour camps offered every summer by teachers at Normandale Elementary, but also offers Computer Typing Skills throughout the year. “Whether we’re diving into new skills or just enjoying the moment, it feels like a space where kids can truly shine and I’m grateful to be part of that,” says May. A Partnership Built on Thriving

Twelve years ago, an Edina parent identified a troubling reality: while our community offers an astonishing array of enrichment opportunities for students, many families simply can't afford to participate. Many of our students, therefore, risk missing out on the kind of out-of-school time experiences that help young people grow, belong and thrive.

What began as a small, grassroots effort to bridge that gap—a two week “Summer is Go Time” program offering a handful of camp options—has blossomed into something remarkable. Today, Edina Give and Go and its 600+ donors serve hundreds of students who can choose from 1,500+ enrichment and care opportunities every year.

“Edina Community Education partners with Edina Give and Go to unlock access to more activities for more students” explains Krista Phillips, who manages the Edina Resource Center and helps coordinate access to the tuition assistance. During the school year, Edina Community Education contributes \$150 per student per semester, which can combine with up to \$500 from Edina Give and Go, to access activities ranging from afterschool choir or chess club to driver’s education. In summer, students can access another \$500, when opportunities like these are needed most.

The flexible, personalized approach is working. “We see many families who wouldn’t otherwise explore choice activities are actually participating in summer or afterschool activities because of the support and financial assistance we are

able to provide,” says Catalina Carrasco, Student Granting Coordinator at Edina Give and Go. “It’s good to see students trying new things in our community.”

The impact goes far beyond keeping kids busy. “Research shows that the more safe, stimulating, and enriching opportunities children have outside of school, the more likely they will flourish and become successful as they grow into adulthood” says Anne Marie Leland, Director of Community Education and Strategic Partnerships. Stephanie Francis-Jones, Executive Director of Give and Go, emphasizes what’s at stake. “When kids don’t participate in summer activities, they return to school in the fall behind their peers who have been going to camps all year long. That learning loss compounds year after year. Enrichment activities can actually help with meeting milestones like 3rd grade reading, 6th grade math, and high school graduation rates.”

The partnership impacts ripple out into the wider community as well. “One thing I love about working on scholarships with families is that the conversation can be a starting point for getting families connected to other community resources,” adds Krista. “The Edina Resource Center can help families find programs offering food, housing and mental health resources, to name a few.” The result is a more resilient and more connected community. “The impact extends to donors as well,” adds Anne Marie. “Donors know that when they donate to Edina Give and Go, they are donating to an aligned, seamless system that leverages resources and supports students as fully and efficiently as possible.”

Going forward, the partnership between Edina Community Education and Edina Give and Go will continue to grow and evolve. “We will continue to work closely with district leaders, social workers, cultural liaisons, teachers and participating families to gain insights into community needs, and we’ll develop new programs to continue to meet those needs,” explains Anne Marie. An example is one of Edina Give and Go’s newest programs: Summer Sports Samplers. This program invites Edina High School coaches and athletes to organize low-cost sports clinics for elementary-aged students. In addition to teaching skills, the older athletes make connections with younger students and model fair play, integrity, and team spirit. “Seeing students’ faces light up—whether it was 100 young children in dance or 35 in baseball—was such a joy,” Stephanie recalls. “It’s just one way we are working every day toward our vision for each and every student to discover their possibilities and thrive.”
