

Homer 33C E-Learning Plan for Snow Day: 2024-2027

Overview

According to Section 10-20.56 of the School Code, school districts may, by adopted resolution, utilize e-learning days in lieu of emergency days. The number of e-learning days may not exceed the number of emergency days in the approved school calendar. The district's e-learning program must be approved by the regional office of education. The superintendent has the discretion to call off school due to severe weather.

Early Childhood, Kindergarten, and First Grade Only

- Students and parents will receive five days of standardized Choice Boards for emergency closings/e-learning days. Students will receive five hours of learning per day.
- All parents should log into SeeSaw in September and October to familiarize themselves with the software.
- Students will turn in school work using the SeeSaw platform.
- Teachers will communicate to parents on Curriculum Night about the use of SeeSaw during emergency closing days.

Early Childhood, Kindergarten, and First Grade Only - Attendance

- During the next day of in-person attendance, students will turn in completed assignments in order to receive attendance credit. Students who turn in all assignments should be marked present in Powerschool for the e-learning day(s).
- Students who complete 99%-50% of the assignments will be marked as present for half-day attendance.
- Students who complete less than 50% of assignments will be marked as absent for the school day.
- Teachers will upload teaching videos to SeeSaw similar to all district teachers.
- Teachers will be available "live" on Google Meet for 60 minutes. Information regarding the specific time and link will be sent by the teacher via SeeSaw.

Early Childhood Through 8th Grade - Goals

- Grade level learning standards will be emphasized.
- Students will receive live instruction with opportunities for questions and feedback.
- Allow for a continuum of learning.
- All 2nd-8th grade students will participate in live sessions with their teachers.
- Students with Individualized Education Plans (IEP), Section 504 Plans and English Learners will have accommodations.

Student Expectations

- Daily attendance will be taken every morning for 2nd-8th grade students.

- Attend all live sessions for your day.
- Please dress appropriately.
- All handbook rules stay in effect during e-learning day.
- Please ask questions for better understanding of the curriculum.
- Please complete and submit all assignments by the due date.
- Be respectful with district laptops, no food or drink near the laptop.
- If you are having technology issues, please email the technology department.

Technology

- Google Classroom will be the online system, 2nd-8th grade students will utilize Google meet for live instruction and to complete assignments for classes.
- Teachers will have a balance between screen time and other activities on an e-learning day.
- If parents do not have a home internet connection, please contact the Technology Department.

2nd-4th Grade Attendance

2nd-4th grade student attendance will be taken at 10:00 a.m. on Google meet.

Principals will create a snow day schedule to share with parents, teachers and paraprofessionals.
