Homework and Late Work Policy

- Turn in classwork/homework on date assigned by teacher
- Pay close attention to Canvas deadlines
- Late Work:
 - 1 day late: -11 points
 - 2 days late: -20 points
 - 3 days late: -30 points

Corrections Policy

A student who receives a failing grade on a classroom assignment or a test (69 and below), can make corrections/retake to earn a 70. The student must attend tutorials or make arrangements with the teacher. If a student fails to correct the assignment or test, that grade will stand.

Make-Up Work

Students who miss work in class due to an absence are permitted to make-up their work. The student is responsible for getting with their teachers for make-up work. Tests should be made up in tutorials or as arranged by the teacher- not during class time.

1-3 days absence= due within 3 days after student returns
4+ days absence= due within 5 days after student returns

Absences

A written note must be presented to the attendance office within 3 days from when a student misses part or a full day of school. When a student has 3+ absences, a letter will be sent to parents reminding them of the "90% Rule" per Texas State Law.

Tardies


Students are expected to be inside the classroom by the end of the tardy bell.

Drinks, Food & Chewing Gum




Deliveries

Due to health and safety concerns, there will be no food deliveries from delivery services.

Fees


Dances
