



## 2025-26 Redefining Our Schools Initiative Update

The 2025-2026 Redefining Our Schools process formally concluded at the January 21, 2026, Regular School Board Meeting. Superintendent Dr. Howard Hepburn presented 12 recommendations for approval. After careful consideration of each item, the School Board voted to approve 11 of the 12 items, thereby establishing the school attendance areas and facility usage for the 2026-2027 school year. The table below outlines the official actions taken by the School Board. In the upcoming week, communications explaining these changes will be sent to parents of students at the specific schools listed below. Additionally, meetings will be held at the schools being consolidated to assist families with these transitions. On behalf of the School Board and the Senior Leadership Team, Superintendent Dr. Howard Hepburn extends their sincere appreciation to our parents, community partners, volunteers, staff, and all stakeholder groups for their participation and valuable contributions to this year's process. Number	Superintendent's Recommendations
MM-1	Consolidate Sunshine ES into Fairway ES and transition the Sunshine ES campus for another District use - <b>APPROVED</b>
MM-2	Consolidate Panther Run ES into Chapel Trail ES and Silver Palms ES and transition the Panther Run ES campus for another District use - <b>APPROVED</b>
MM-3	Consolidate Palm Cove ES into Pines Lakes ES and Lakeside ES and transition the Palm Cove ES campus for another District use - <b>APPROVED</b>
MM-4	Consolidate North Fork ES into Croissant Park ES, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. ES, Thurgood Marshall ES, and Walker ES and transition the North Fork ES campus for another use - <b>APPROVED</b>
MM-5	Shift the portion of the Walter C. Young MS boundary west of I-75 to Silver Trail MS, so that beginning in the 2026-27 school year students in this area will be assigned to Silver Trail MS - <b>APPROVED</b>
MM-6	Consolidate Plantation MS into Plantation HS, reconfigure Plantation HS as a sixth through twelfth-grade school, and transition the Plantation MS campus for another District use - <b>APPROVED</b>
MM-7	Consolidate Bair MS into Westpine MS and transition the Bair MS campus for another District use - <b>NOT APPROVED</b>
MM-8	Shift the portion of the Charles W. Flanagan HS boundary west of I-75 West Broward HS, so that beginning in the 2026-27 school year students in this area will be assigned to West Broward HS - <b>APPROVED AS PHASE-INS</b>
MM-9	Shift the portion of the Hallandale HS boundary west of I-95 to Miramar HS, so that beginning in the 2026-27 school year students in this area will be assigned to Miramar HS and Hallandale HS will be transitioned to a four-day-week magnet school following the Pompano Beach HS model - <b>APPROVED AS PHASE-INS</b>
MM-10	Reconfigure Thurgood Marshall ES as a birth through fifth-grade early learning center - <b>APPROVED</b>
MM-11	Consolidate Seagull Alt. HS into Whiddon-Rogers Ed. Ctr. and transition the Seagull Alt. HS campus for another use - <b>APPROVED</b>
MM-12	All other school attendance area boundaries and school usage will remain the same in the 2026-27 school year as they are in the 2025-26 school year ( <b>including Bair MS and Westpine MS</b> ) or previously adopted grade phase-ins - <b>APPROVED</b>
