



Financial Counseling Acknowledgement

College Credit Plus is free for all public-school students who wish to attend a public Ohio university or college. That means no cost for tuition, books, or fees if you attend public school in the state of Ohio. If you choose to attend a private college, you may have limited costs.

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 3365.09(A), a district may seek reimbursement from a student or parent if the student fails to attain a passing final grade. Current interpretation of this statute shall allow, but not require, a school district or nonpublic school as appropriate to seek reimbursement under the following two circumstances:

1. If the student receives a failing grade at the end of the college course.
2. If the student withdraws from or drops the college course subsequent to the 14th calendar day after the course began.

Pursuant to Section 3365.09(C), neither a school district nor a nonpublic school shall seek reimbursement if the student is identified as being economically disadvantaged in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code 3333-1-65.6(E).
