



BNT@W Out-of-District Application Checklist

Because you live outside the district, you must complete **two separate applications**. Acceptance into New Tech is contingent upon both applications being approved.

Phase 1: The BNT@W Campus Application

This is the first step to express interest in the school of choice. BNT@W admits students on a first-come, first-serve basis.

- **Step 1: Fill out the [BNT@W Online Application](#).**
 - **Requirement:** Students must complete a short personal essay as part of the application.
 - **Waitlist:** There are 120 spots per grade level. Once filled, students are placed on a waitlist.
- **Step 2: The Interview/Meeting.**
 - All families must meet with the school administration prior as part of the application process.
 - Please bring the most recent Report Card, Attendance Records, and Discipline Records from current school attending along with current 504 or IEP paperwork if applicable to the student.
 - If applying for 10th, 11th, or 12th grade, have a current transcript.

Phase 2: The Interdistrict Transfer Application

Since you reside outside Belton ISD, you must also be approved as a transfer student by the district.

- **Step 2: Submit the Out-of-District (Interdistrict) Transfer Application.**
 - **Window:** This application typically opens on **February 10th** and closes in **early March**.
 - **Link:** Available at bisd.net/transfer.
 - **Criteria for Approval:** The district evaluates the student's attendance history, discipline records, and available space.
 - **Fees:** Note that out-of-district transfers for non-employees may require tuition/transfer fees (e.g., ~\$500 per semester for high school).

Phase 3: Enrollment & Commitment

Once accepted by New Tech @Waskow and approved for out of district enrollment by Belton ISD

- **Step 1: Sign the Commitment.**
 - All accepted students sign a **one-year commitment** to attend BNT@W.
- **Step 2: Enrollment**
 - The Belton ISD new student enrollment link will be emailed to you and you can enroll your student.

Important Notes

- **Transportation:** Belton ISD **does not** provide transportation for out-of-district transfer students. Parents are responsible for all travel to and from campus.
- **Yearly Renewal:** Transfer applications must be resubmitted and approved **every year** to remain enrolled.
