Dear Parents and Families,

As we prepare for the possibility of winter weather and potential school closures, I want to ensure that all of our scholars are able to continue learning safely from home.

If school is closed, each student will be responsible for completing a ELA and Math packet. Every child will receive a hard copy of these materials in advance, and an electronic copy can be retrieved here or from the school's website and on Class Dojo for easy access.

If weather conditions allow and your family has power, scholars are encouraged to spend one hour each day on i-Ready—30 minutes in Reading and 30 minutes in Math—to keep their skills sharp.

If your power is out, please don't worry. Scholars should simply:

- Read a book each day, and
- Write a 3–5 sentence summary of what they read.

In addition:

- K–2 students should practice addition and subtraction fluency.
- Grades 3–5 students should practice multiplication and division fluency.
