What we're learning



Math

The students will wrap up unit 5 on money. Student's have learned the total value of combining pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters. It is important that the students are fluent in skip counting by 5s, 10s, and 25s. The test will be on 1/22.



Reading

Students will continue unit 5 with text set 2 The students will read a fiction and non-fiction text.

Phonics:

Students will continue lesson 17 reviewing the vowel teams for the test. Their test will be on 1/22
