For the 2026-2027 School Year

Now Open!!! FULL DAY Pre-K

If you are interested in sending your child to our Pre-K program in September, you must register them. You may find information on registration at Cheektowagasloan.org □ Central Registration. There are 4 ways to register:

- 1.) Online registration at www.cheektowagasloan.org
- 2.) In person registration (By appointment only – please call 716-891-6427)
- 3.) Drop off or mail in registration (can be printed from district website)
- 4.) Hybrid registration (Begin online & finish in person)

Eligibility requirements are:

- Your child must be 4 years old on or before December 1st, 2026.
- You must reside in the Cheektowaga-Sloan School District.
- You must provide your child's transportation to and from school. Hours are 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

To register any student you will need the following items:

Student Identification: Birth certificate, passport or other documentary evidence of birth date

Parent Identification: Legal parent/guardian photo identification, such as a Driver's License

Proof of Immunizations and Health Appraisal: Records provided by Doctor's office

Three (3) Proofs of Residence: Housing documents, utilities, payroll stub, government records

Guardianship Documents: if applicable, court documentation identifying residential custody

There is no cost for families to participate. Our program runs 6 hours per day, 5 days per week, and follows the school district's calendar. Register by **Thursday, April 16th** to participate in the lottery draw on **April 30th**, if required. Once the program is filled, students will be added to the waitlist.

Our quality program utilizes research based, age-appropriate practices which are aligned with NY State's Pre-K Standards. Your child will acquire pre-reading skills, a richer vocabulary, and strong basic math skills. Pre-K children will be exposed to numbers, letters, shapes, and words. They will learn how to share, take turns, cooperate, follow directions, solve problems, and contribute to the classroom community. Theodore Roosevelt's Pre-K students will grow socially, emotionally, physically, and intellectually, which will better prepare them for Kindergarten.
