The 2026-2027 RPCS calendar provides **171** school days (Monday, August 31, 2026 – Thursday, June 3, 2027).

Once one inclement weather closing has been used, RPCS will move to virtual learning days. If for any reason the school is required to add more in-person days to the calendar to meet the required number of annual school days, then the following days may be added: Monday, March 22 (2nd Monday of Spring Break), Monday, March 29 (Employee Professional Day), and/or Monday, May 31 (Memorial Day).

The RPCS school-year calendar is set in coordination with the calendars at Bryn Mawr School and Gilman School.

- 1) For Lower, Middle and Upper School, the school year generally begins on the Wednesday before Labor Day except when in conflict with a religious holiday or to achieve the requisite number of days.
- 2) For the 2026-2027 school year, RPCS' Commencement will be on Thursday, June 3. The Bryn Mawr School Commencement will be on Friday, June 4. Gilman School's Commencement will be on Saturday, June 5.
- 3) Winter and spring breaks aim to provide a combined total of approximately three school weeks of vacation.
- 4) There are three professional development days during the school year: one day each in the fall, winter, and spring.

- 5) For holidays, the tri-schools are closed for the first day of Rosh Hashanah and on Yom Kippur when they fall on a school day, Labor Day, the Wednesday before Thanksgiving, Thanksgiving Day, the Friday after Thanksgiving, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, Presidents' Day, Good Friday, and Memorial Day. During summer, school is also closed on Juneteenth and Independence Day.
