SUBJECT: **HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION RATES, 2024-2025**


On Tuesday, January 13, 2026, the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) released Federal graduation rates for Florida and the 67 school districts. State and district data are located online at the FLDOE Education Information & Accountability Services Website:

According to the 2024-2025 High School Graduation Rate FLDOE press release, "Florida's historic graduation rate reflects the power of Governor DeSantis' strong leadership, clear expectations, and unwavering commitment to student success," said Commissioner Anastasios Kamoutsas. "These achievements demonstrate what can be accomplished when we uphold rigorous standards, provide robust support to schools, and prepare every student for success beyond graduation."

At the district level, Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) achieved its highest high school graduation rate in the past 25 years, surpassing 90 percent for the first time. Figure 1 illustrates the BCPS Federal Uniform Graduation Rate for 25 years.

Graduation rates in this memorandum will compare 2024-2025 to 2023-2024. Highlights from this data include:

- BCPS Federal Graduation Rate is 91.4%, which represents a 2.4 percentage points increase from 2023-2024 (89.0%).
- The 2024-2025 graduation rate for Hispanic students, American Indian or Alaska Native students, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander students, and White students in Broward exceeds the State rate.
- 36 of 36 traditional District high schools achieved a graduation rate of 90% or higher, and 31 of these schools reached a rate of 95% or higher.
- Seven District high schools earned 100% graduation rates: **Atlantic Technical High School, College Academy at Broward College, Lauderhill 6-12, McFatter Technical High School, Millennium 6-12 Collegiate Academy, Pompano Beach High School, and Sheridan Technical High School.** College Academy at Broward College achieved a 100% graduation rate for the 14th consecutive year.
- Seven District high schools increased graduation rates by 3 or more percentage points in 2024-2025 compared to 2023-2024: **Blanche Ely High, Coconut Creek High, Deerfield Beach High, Hollywood Hills High, J.P. Taravella High, McArthur High, and Plantation High.**
- Florida's Federal graduation rate was 92.2% in 2024-2025, up 2.5 percentage points from 89.7% in 2023-2024.

This memo will also provide further detail and analysis, including comparisons of graduation rates for Florida's five largest districts and by school.

Table 1 displays the historical graduation rates for Florida's five largest districts and the State as a whole. In 2024-2025, Broward's graduation rate was 91.4.

Table 2 contains the 2024-2025 graduation rates for Florida's five largest districts and the State by subgroup. The 2024-2025 graduation rate for Hispanic and White students in Broward exceeds the State rate. The 2024-2025 graduation rate for Students with Disabilities (SWD) in Broward County matched the State rate.



Figure 2 illustrates the ten-year historical graduation rates for BCPS traditional District high schools, BCPS overall (including high schools, centers, and charter schools), and Florida. BCPS traditional District high schools achieved graduation rates that were consistently higher than the state, reaching 97.5% in 2024-25.

Table 4 presents the graduation rates for the major racial and ethnic groups served in BCPS. The graduation rates increased for Black, Hispanic, and White students. In 2024-2025, the gap between Black and White students decreased by 2.4 percentage points, and the gap between Hispanic and White students decreased by 0.9 percentage points compared to the previous year, 2023-2024.

Table 5 shows the graduation rates by subgroups served in BCPS. English Language Learners (ELL) showed the largest increase in graduation rate, up 5.3 percentage points from 2023-2024. SWD showed a 2.3 percentage point increase in graduation rate compared to 2023-2024. Free and Reduced-Price Lunch (FRL) students showed a 3.0 percentage point increase in graduation rate compared to 2023-2024. The graduation rate gap between FRL and Non-FRL students decreased by 1.9 percentage points compared to 2023-2024. The gap for SWD and Non-SWD students remained stable. The graduation rate gap between ELL and Non-ELL students decreased by 3.2 percentage points to 7.8.
