Q: How can premium dollars/bond dollars be spent in the school district? Can we use this money on...Field Trips?

A: No. Premium dollars are connected to the Bond, therefore, they can only be spent in facility-related items.

Q: Sports equipment/ music equipment/extracurricular activities?

A: Extra curricular activities cannot be covered with premium dollars. Sports and music equipment only when construction of the new building or areas of existing buildings require items fixed to buildings (i.e. basketball courts or wall speakers).

Q: PARAs/ Mental Health advocates/ Safety Advocates?

A: This is not an allowable expenditure with premium dollars.

Q: Scholarships?

A: This is not an allowable expenditure with premium dollars.

Q: New security system/cameras?

A: Yes, this is an expense that is allowable as these are artifacts fixed to buildings. In fact, this is being covered for all schools with the bond dollars already.

Q: When will the new middle school be completed/ where can I find information about this project?
