The ongoing water issues have undoubtedly been a challenge for our community, and we appreciate everyone's patience and flexibility. We are thankful to be able to have school open and operating as usual today.

At this time, all water fountains have been turned off. Bathrooms remain fully operational, and sinks in classrooms, bathrooms, and the nurse's office may be used for handwashing as usual.

To ensure that students, staff and faculty have access to safe drinking water, our custodial team has placed bottled strategically throughout the building for those who may need it. We will continue to monitor our supply and replenish as needed. If possible, families may also wish to send students to school with an additional bottle of drinking water.

We will continue to monitor the situation closely and hope it is fully resolved as soon as possible. Please do not hesitate to reach out if you have any questions or concerns.
