

Register for Diablo Valley College (DVC) courses and earn college credit—while still in high school!

Who is Eligible?

Any high school student (including homeschooled students) can participate, with approval from their school.

Note: This is not part of a CCAP dual enrollment program. Students enroll independently and can take classes that work with their schedule and goals.

How Many Classes Can I Take?

High school students may take up to 11 units per semester.

What Does It Cost?

California high school students do not pay tuition!

You'll Only Need to Pay:

- Student union and representation fees
- Any required textbooks or materials

Will the Classes Be on My Transcript?

Yes! All courses taken through concurrent enrollment appear on your official DVC transcript.

Check with your high school about whether they'll also add it to your high school transcript.

A **pathway** is a sequence of two or three courses. Pathway courses are **career-themed** and have **special funding** to make sure students have **access** to the latest and greatest **technology** and **opportunities**.

Students who complete a pathway benefit from



Woodworking Technology





Woodworking Technology

introduces a student to the basic skills of cabinet making, furniture making and carpentry. The student will be able to demonstrate knowledge of hand and power tool operation and appreciate safe working practices, and to use materials with understanding and conservation and students will explore occupational and a vocational interest in wood designs.

Engineering Essentials

Engineering Essentials is an introductory course to electrical, mechanical, and civil engineering. Students will learn how to wire circuits, create simple robots, and work with mapping technology.

Medical Terminology & Emergency Medicine




Medical Terminology is a critical course in Healthcare. Students will learn the language of Human Anatomy, Physiology, Diseases, Diagnosis and Treatment.



Spanish I, Spanish II, Spanish for Spanish Speakers




Spanish I is the entry beginning course. **Spanish II, or Spanish for Spanish Speakers** is the course for those that speak Spanish at home fluently and will learn training in oral skills, reading comprehension, grammar and composition.

Art 1




Art 1 is a course covering the fundamentals of art. Students will learn different techniques in drawing, painting, and sculpture.



Ceramics

Ceramics is a course covering the fundamentals of learn how to construct forms using hand-building techniques and create colourful and decorative surface patterns. Students will learn different techniques on the pottery wheel, hand built forms, and glaze ceramic pieces.

Film Studies is a course in appreciating and studying the art of films. Students will learn how to analyze movies, learn about how movies are made, and learn about the history of film.



Link Crew is a leadership program that focuses on making select individuals from the Junior and Senior classes, known as "Link Leaders," into mentors for freshmen and new students.




What will my schedule look like next year?

ALL 9th graders are required to take English I, PE, Living Earth, *Algebra, & 2 electives


