

school-aged childcare program description

Our multi-age program offers a rich, engaging array of activities and experiences within a fun developmentally appropriate program model. Youth participate in making choices about how they prefer to spend their time. Activity choices include outdoor play, gym time, free play, social enrichment and themed activities. The program provides an afternoon snack.

Monthly payments are based on 10 installments of your annual contract. Monthly tuitions are debited through our online registration portal, Community Pass on the 15th of the month previous to service. September tuition is drafted in August 2026 and payments end in May 2027.

The after-school program follows the NPS school calendar. If the school building is closed, then the program is also closed. The after-school program does not offer childcare for the following:

- Early Release Days*
- Staff Development Days
- Holidays –Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran’s Day, Thanksgiving Break, Christmas Day, New Year’s Day, MLK Day, February Break, April Break, Memorial Day & Juneteenth
- School Vacation Weeks (Christmas, February and April)*
- School closures due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances

**The YWCA may offer programming to coincide with school closures (early release days and February/April vacation weeks). Offerings are based on staff & space availability as well as family needs. Offerings will be broadcast to all after-school participants as information becomes available. School’s Out participants get priority in all programs.*

Enrollment Process

- Monday, May 4, 2025 - Priority Registration (current participants and their siblings)
- Monday, May 18, 2025 – Waitlist Registration (2025-26 waitlisted families)
- Monday, June 1, 2025 (9am) – General Public Registration (new families)

The YWCA does not maintain an interest/waitlist for incoming 2026-27 families.

Registration is in our online registration portal (Community Pass). You will need to set up a family account. You can create an account by going to our website at www.ywcanewburyport.org and clicking on the online registration button which will bring you to community pass and ask you to sign in or allow you to create an account.

Registration is complete when you have done all the following:

1. Paid your registration fee
2. Saved your financial information to your account to be set up in autopay system.
3. Return completed paperwork (listed below) by August 1st.
 - Intake Packet (download from our website)
 - Current Physical and Immunizations Record (within a year)
 - Any applicable supporting documents (custodial orders, restraining orders, individual healthcare plans for allergies/medical issues, applicable medications, supportive and/or adaptive plans).
