Registration Overview:

At Eastview, the school year has four nine-week quarters, and each day includes seven periods. This means you can take up to 28 courses per year (4 quarters x 7 periods). Each course is worth 0.75 credits per quarter, so a year-long course equals 3 credits. As a sophomore, you must choose between 24-28 courses. Picking 28 gives you a full schedule, while choosing fewer means study halls will be added. Your final schedule, including any study halls, will be available online in mid-August.

What courses should I take?

Use this worksheet to guide your selection process. Full-year required core courses (English, Social Studies, Mathematics and Science) are listed below; choose one sequence in each category and select all four quarter courses (Q1/2/3/4) to meet the full-year requirement. Required PE/Wellness courses are listed next. There are **17 required courses** to take sophomore year; make sure you have selected/circled 17 courses on this page.

This leaves you with **up to 11 elective choices**. Elective courses are listed on the next page of this worksheet, with full-year courses first (World Languages, Choir and Band), and quarter electives at the end. Courses with pre-requisites and other recommendations are identified with an *; complete descriptions and additional details can be found online at www.evhs.district196.org/academics/registration.
