Registration Overview:

At Eastview, the school year has four nine-week quarters, and each day includes seven periods. This means you can take up to 28 courses per year (4 quarters x 7 periods). Each course is worth 0.75 credits per quarter, so a year-long course equals 3 credits. As a senior, you must choose between 20-28 courses. Picking 28 gives you a full schedule, while choosing fewer means study halls will be added. Your final schedule, including any study halls, will be available online in mid-August.

What courses should I take?

Use this worksheet to help choose your courses. Full-year **required core** classes—English, Social Studies, Math, and Science—are listed below. Seniors must take a full year of English and Social Studies to meet the four year graduation requirements; Math and Science require three years; so depending on post high school plans (and your past success), you may or may not need another year (consult with your Counselor if you have questions). If you haven't taken and passed Wellness 3 yet, don't forget to include it in your senior year selections.

Next, choose your **electives**. Full-year electives (like World Languages, Choir, and Band) are listed first on the next page, followed by quarter electives. Courses with prerequisites or recommendations are marked with an *, and you can find full details online at www.evhs.district196.org/academics/registration.
