

# DELAYED SCHEDULE/CANCELLATION PLAN

## Mater Dei High School

The following learning plans will be followed if there was a delayed schedule or cancellation for the day:

### TWO HOUR DELAY SCHEDULE

- Door Open at 8:30am
- Arrival Bell Rings at 9:20am

Block 3 / Block 7: 10:30am-12:05pm (Lunch)

Block 2 / Block 6: 12:10-1:05pm

**OFF CAMPUS CLASSES:** *When EVSC is on a two-hour delay on the same day, those students that attend SICTC, Shepard Law or ASM will report to their off campus classes two hours later. Additional instructions will be provided on where students will go when they arrive or depart Mater Dei.*

### SCHOOL CANCELLATION PROCEDURES

In the event of school cancellation due to weather or emergencies, Mater Dei High School will utilize one of the following learning processes:

#### **Virtual Learning (Asynchronous: Students work independently on assignments.)**

- Assignments will be posted on Google Classroom by 8:00am on the day of cancellation.
- Assignments are due the next schedule day of class
  - *Example: If we're out on a Red Day, the assignments will be due the next Red Day.*
- Teachers will be available from 8am-2pm and can be reached via email with any questions.

#### **Virtual Learning (Synchronous: Students will meet with teachers at assigned times.)**

Block 1 / Block 5: 8:00am


Block 2 / Block 6: 9:00am


Block 3 / Block 7: 10:00am

Block 4 / Block 8: 11:00am

- Assignments will be posted on Google Classroom at the start of the class.
- Students will log into their class and **join** the **Google Meet** at the listed time above (they may be on hold until the teacher starts the class).

- Students will wear appropriate attire and will also be in an appropriate place while attending their Google Meet.
- Teachers will interact, assign and collect work through Google Classroom.
- Teachers will provide a minimum of 20 minutes of live instruction during each class.
- Teachers will share expectations, on-line links and other tools needed for the class.
- Assignments are due the next schedule day of class
  - *Example: If we're out on a Red Day, the assignments will be due the next Red Day.*

 This option will not be used when inclement weather or emergencies are unexpected and students do not have advanced warning.

 Extracurricular practices will not take place before 12:30pm and must be over by 4:00pm.

## POTENTIAL MAKE-UP DAYS

- In the event of consecutive cancelled days, the school will utilize snow make up days noted on the school calendar.

## COMMUNICATION

- Notification of a delayed schedule or cancellation will take place as soon as possible. It is the goal of the school to notify parents/guardians as early as possible on the day of the delayed schedule or cancellation.
