GRADING SYSTEM

For a student to earn credit for a course that is a full year, the average of the two semesters grades must equal a minimum of 70.

Grade points are awarded based on the grade earned and the designation of the course as On-level, Advanced, Dual Credit, Or AP. LPS On-level courses are on a weighted 5.0 GPA Scale. The minimum passing mark is a 2.0

GPA & Rank in Class

Per board policy, LPS does not rank students past the Top 10%. Students in the top 10% will have an exact rank listed on their transcripts.

Student grade point average reflects a cumulative GPA for all final grades earned in approved high school courses documented on the high school transcript.

High school credit earned prior to 9th grade is included; however, only Algebra I and Geometry taken in 7th and/or 8th grades and Spanish I taken in 8th grade receive grade points. Other junior high courses are excluded from the Ranking GPA calculation.
