Curriculum Notes: What's Coming Up?

Math 1: Students will have their mid unit math test. It will cover comparing numbers, ten more and ten less, and solving addition and subtraction equations and word problems. (Practice and Homework Journal pages 41-42)

Math 2: Students will begin Unit 6 by reviewing skip counting, place value to 1,000 and 10 more/ten less, 100 more/100 less. (Practice and Homework Journal pages 93-94)

Reading and Phonics: Next week we will be reading both fantasy and nonfiction texts. Students will look at story elements, focusing on the problems and solutions, as well as using text features. In phonics, we will learn the phonics pattern for long vowel e, silent e words.

Writing: Students will continue to work on irregular verbs. Students will use text evidence to respond to a fantasy story.

Science: We will continue to learn about severe weather focusing on heatwaves and blizzards. Students will do an experiment to create a snowstorm in jar.

Student Success Skills: Students will identify a goal and how to reach it.
