Preschool

Age:
18 months to 3 years old

Hours:

Fees: We offer a variety of funding options to fit every need including free or low cost for qualifying families and affordable tuition-based options.

In Preschool I will...

- ...explore letters, numbers and symbols
- ...explore pre-math and science concepts
- ...be curious and participate in hands-on investigative play
- ...explore movements through sensory play
- ...strengthen hand muscles through playdough, coloring, lacing, and cutting
- ...participate in cooperative play
- ...explore friendships and sharing

Age: 4 years old by 9/1/26

Academic

- ...learn my letters and sounds
- ...develop math concepts like sorting and patterning
- ...learn to count and recognize numbers through play




Physical

In Kindergarten I will...

Academic

- ...learn to read words and sentences
- ...learn to write words and sentences
- ...learn to add and subtract numbers up to 10

Physical

- ...develop my pencil grasp for writing
- ...develop hand-eye coordination and balance
- ...learn to run, skip, pedal a trike, toss and catch a ball

Social

- ...learn how to express feelings to friends and teachers
- ...understand how to follow directions
- ...collaborate with my classmates



Preschool, Transitional Kindergarten (TK), & Kindergarten (K)



What is MVUSD's Preschool Program?

Our Early Learning Center is a comprehensive early childhood development center for children ages 18 months to 3 years old. The center offers several childcare options that aim to meet the needs of the whole child and their families with quality and nurturing care. The district's educational approach provides engaging hands-on learning and activities by child development professionals.

What are the hours of operation?

Full day preschool is open from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Part-day preschool has two sessions. The morning session is from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m.; the afternoon session is from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

What is the cost of Preschool at MVUSD?

There are two options based on family income eligibility: free or sliding scale. Income guidelines are listed on the MVUSD website, earlylearning.mvUSD.org

What is the location of the Early Learning Center?

The MVUSD Early Learning Center is centrally located in Murrieta at: 25664 Madison Ave. To schedule a tour, please call (951) 304-1623.

What is Transitional Kindergarten?

TK is the newest grade level in California that bridges preschool and kindergarten. Credentialed teachers with childhood development expertise lead 4 year old students through activities and hands-on learning in the areas of academics, social and physical skills. TK supports all 4 year olds to become independent, self-confident learners.

Who is eligible to enroll in TK?

All children who turn 4 years old by 9/1/2026.

Who is eligible to enroll in kindergarten?

Children born between 9/2/2020 - 9/1/2021.

What is the cost of TK & K?

TK & Kinder are free. There is no fee for traditional half-day schedules.

What is the schedule for TK & K?

TK & Kinder are part-time, three-hours programs and follow the traditional am or pm schedule.

What is the extended day option for TK & K?

The extended day option compliments the TK academic day with fee based (free for qualifying families) enrichment activities through the end of the school day. This option is separate from SEED, the before & after school child care program.

What is SEED for TK & K?

SEED is MVUSD's before and after-school childcare program, providing wrap around services for elementary aged students between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 6 p.m. This is a high-demand service and space is limited. SEED is a fee based service that has several payment options and may be free or low cost for qualifying families.

Is there bus transportation for TK & K students?
