



**Notification to Parents/Guardians – Title I, Part A
Right to Ask for Teacher’s and Paraeducator’s Qualifications**

Dear Coquille School District Parents and Guardians,

Federal education law requires all schools receiving Title I, Part A funds to inform parents/guardians of their right to ask about the professional qualifications of their child’s teachers and paraprofessionals (also called instructional assistants, educational assistants, or a teacher’s aide). A paraprofessional provides academic or other support for students under the direct supervision of a teacher.

Our school receives Title I, Part A funding and we are happy to share this information with you upon your request. If you ask for this information, we will provide you with the following as soon as possible:


1. Whether your student's teacher:
 - d. Has met Oregon licensure requirements for the grade levels and subject areas the teacher is currently teaching;
 - e. Is teaching under an emergency or other provisional status through which Oregon qualifications or licensure/endorsement criteria have been waived; and
 - f. Is teaching in the field that they received their certification to teach.

2. Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.
