PRIVATE SCHOOL SATELLITE PROGRAM

(Full-time Non-accredited Home School)

The King's Academy Private School Satellite Program (PSP) provides support for home-schooled families with children in grades K-12. The basic program includes academic record maintenance, legal coverage, curriculum selection assistance, group activities, and one-to-one consultation with experienced leadership.

PRIVATE SCHOOL SATELLITE PROGRAM FEES

Non-refundable application fee per family:

Before June 1 deadline (*space permitting*)\$80
 After June 1 (*case-by-case, space permitting*).....\$160

Non-refundable registration fee per student:

Annual fee due upon acceptance
 Kindergarten-5th grade \$66
 6th-8th grade (*space permitting*)..... \$112
 9th-12th grade (*space permitting*)..... \$223
 After June 1, *add'l late reg. fee per family*..... \$103

Tuition fee per family:

Annual Tuition (*due June 1*)..... \$530
 OR

Two-payment option for continuing families:

Tuition installments (*due June 1 and Dec 1*)..... \$275

High school setup fee for new students:

Non-refundable fee due upon acceptance
 New 9th grader \$225
 New 10th grader \$281
 New 11th grader \$338
 New 12th grader (*by exception*)..... \$450

 High School Football \$510

APPLYING TO PSP

1. Please email The King's Academy PSP office for an application package. Applications may be requested starting February 5.
2. Submit Application, Reference and Fee.
Priority Application Deadline March 1.
Regular Application Deadline June 1.
3. Schedule Parent-Teacher and Student(s) Interview
4. Await Decision - Families will be notified starting in March of the Admissions decision

Participation in TKA activities or campus classes requires an additional application process, set of requirements, and payment.

TAX-DEDUCTIBLE CONTRIBUTIONS

NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

The King's Academy has a non-discriminatory racial policy and admits students of all races to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities made available to all regularly enrolled students.

PAYMENT POLICIES

1. Tuition must be paid in full. Continuing families may choose a two-payment plan.
2. A \$25 late fee is applied when payments are not received by the due date.
3. A \$25 service charge is applied for all returned checks and incorrect online payments.
4. Students are not permitted to continue in the Private School Satellite Program if their tuition or paperwork is more than 30 days delinquent, unless prior arrangements are made.
5. Once a family begins school in any particular month, tuition payment for the entire year is required.
6. Online payments are utilized. Separate payments are required for PSP program and all other TKA activities such as sports fees, retreats, etc.
