Grades 9–10: EOC-Focused Instruction

Students in grades 9 and 10 will participate in **asynchronous instructional activities** aligned to **Tennessee EOC standards** in the following subject areas:

- Algebra I
- Algebra II
- Geometry
- English I
- English II
- Biology

- Review of item types and academic vocabulary commonly assessed on EOC exams

Grades 11–12: EOC and ACT Readiness

Students in grades 11 and 12 will engage in asynchronous learning focused on **U.S. History EOC preparation** and **ACT readiness**.
