## Redmond Middle School Electives

### 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Elective Wheel

This class introduces all 6<sup>th</sup> grade students, except those taking yearlong music, to the Redmond Middle School Elective Program. Students will experience a ten-week introduction to each of the following subjects: Art, Foods, STEM, and Music.

#### Band 1

This course is an introduction to the middle school music ensemble experience. The instruments offered are from the woodwind, brass, and percussion families. Students will build upon knowledge of music literacy, vocabulary, expression, skills, and techniques as it relates to their specific instrument and their role within the instrumental ensemble. Students will demonstrate their learning through school and community performances. No prior band experience is required. Evening concert participation is required.

#### Orchestra 1

This course is an introduction to the middle school music ensemble experience. The instruments offered are violin, viola, cello, and double bass. Students will build upon knowledge of music literacy, vocabulary, expression, skills, and techniques as it relates to their specific instrument and their role within the ensemble. Students will demonstrate their learning through school and community performances. No prior string experience is required. Evening concert participation is required.

#### Choir

This course is an introduction to the middle school music ensemble experience. Students will use their singing voice as their instrument. They will build upon their knowledge of music literacy, vocabulary, expression, skills and vocal technique and their role within the choral ensemble. Students will demonstrate their learning through school and community performances. No prior choir experience is required. All 6<sup>th</sup> grade students (beginner and experienced): evening concert participation is required.
