Informational Item: Principal's Update

- A. GLIDE-board meeting was last night; new school allotment guidelines proposed and money saving strategies; threshold for counselor and 2<sup>nd</sup> AP was made higher-now a school will need 1000 students to get a 2<sup>nd</sup> AP or counselor position. Per pupil allocation \$120/student; has gone down from 175 and 130; CTAE program budget cut; flex dollars going down to average teacher salary (from average counselor salary); teacher furlough day ; these will be voted on in December
