**School District Question 2  
Renewal of Expiring Capital Project Levy  
Authorization**

The school board of Special School District No. 6 (South St. Paul Public Schools) has also proposed to renew the school district's existing capital project levy authorization of 3.74709208482% times the net tax capacity of the school district, which is scheduled to expire after taxes payable in 2029. The money raised from the capital project levy authorization will provide funds for the acquisition, installation, replacement, support and maintenance of classroom technology, software, computers, student devices, improved technology systems, networks, infrastructure, instructional technology, safety and security systems, and related training and personnel costs; deferred maintenance projects and the acquisition of curriculum, textbooks and materials. The proposed capital project levy authorization will raise approximately \$1,139,395 for taxes payable in 2030, the first year it is to be levied, and would be authorized for ten years. The estimated total cost of the projects to be funded over that time period is approximately \$11,393,950. The projects have received a positive Review and Comment from the Commissioner of Education.
