What is Dual Credit?

Dual credit courses have the rigor of a junior college course and allows a student to simultaneously earn high school and college credit.

Dual credit courses are taught by a Lee College professor or a BHHS teacher who also serves as an adjunct professor for Lee College.

Dual credit courses are taught at BHHS, with a few exceptions.

Dual credit courses are weighted on a 5.5 GPA scale.

The cost is \$58.52 per credit hour (Example: US History = 6 credit hours = \$351.12).

Students may need to purchase college textbooks or resources which could cost \$100-\$200 per course each semester.

The formula for User ID & Password for myLC Campus Account and Blackboard should as follows:

Student Login: The FIRST-TWO characters of the First-name followed by the FIRST-TWO characters of the Last-name followed by the ENTIRE Student ID#. (example: TIGU1234567)

Student Password: Stu# followed by your YEAR-Of-Birth (four digits). (example: Stu#2009)

Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

FERPA form must be signed by the student at Lee College if the student wants parent/guardian to have access to their student records.

Authorization is good until student revokes it.
