

### IBDP Visual Arts (Group 6)

Visual arts are taught over 4 hours per week. There is additional studio time available one afternoon a week for students. A photography suite and studio are both available with students at ICS London developing a huge range of creative pieces - both 2D and 3D.

If a student is working towards art college, the teachers are experienced in assisting with portfolio preparation.

ICS London students have access to a whole range of galleries and experiences to support their work in visual arts. Trips are organised by the teachers and students are encouraged to explore beyond the school day too.
