On **Saturday, April 11 beginning at 8:30AM**, there will be placement tests given for Mathematics and Foreign Language.

The Mathematics placement test is **required for all incoming students to Grade 7 (Class of 2032), Grade 8 (Class of 2031) and Grade 9 (Class of 2030)**. The results of this test will help the Mathematics Department determine the correct level for your son's/daughter's mathematics course. Students should bring two #2 pencils. Calculators are not permitted. The Mathematics test will take 60 minutes.

Immediately following the Mathematics placement test, a **Foreign Language placement test** will be given. The Foreign Language test is **required for all incoming students to Grade 8 (Class of 2031) and Grade 9 (Class of 2030)**. The test will take 45 minutes. **Please make sure that you indicate your choice of French or Spanish for September 2026 on the Foreign Language Form.**

Both of the included forms must be completed by Saturday, April 11. You may email the completed packet to me at my address below, or you may bring the completed packet with you on April 11.
