**RESOLUTION OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF THE
STEELTON-HIGHSPIRE SCHOOL DISTRICT REGARDING
THE READY TO LEARN BLOCK GRANT –
TAX EQUITY SUPPLEMENT**

WHEREAS, the School Board of the Steelton-Highspire School District (herein “School Board”) has adopted the following Resolution that pertains to the District’s allocation of the Tax Equity Supplement as required by 24 P.S. § 25-2599.6(g)(3)(iii).

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 311(a) and (d) of the Act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp. Sess., P.L. 1873, No. 1), known as the Taxpayer Relief Act, the School Board has adopted a preliminary budget that declares the District’s intent to receive and use the available monies for a purpose specified under 24 P.S. § 25-2599.6(g)(3)(iii) during the subsequent fiscal year for which the monies have been appropriated by the general assembly;

WHEREAS, 24 P.S. § 25-2599.6(g)(3)(iii) permits the District to use the available monies for the following purposes:

- (A) Mitigating or preventing an increase in the millage rate of real estate property taxes levied by the school district
- (B) Supplementing the amount calculated by the school district for the homestead and farmstead exclusion under section 342 of the Taxpayer Relief Act.
- (C) Establishing, maintaining, or expanding a program provided by the school district that supplements the rebates provided under Chapter 13 of the Taxpayer Relief Act.
- (D) Mitigating or replacing the loss of revenue received by the school district resulting from a decision of a court of this Commonwealth within the previous five years relating to an assessment appeal under Article V of the act of May 22, 1933 (P.L.853, No.155), known as The General County Assessment Law.
- (E) Reducing debt.

WHEREAS, the District has been allocated a Tax Equity Supplement in the amount of \$153,499.07.

NOW, THEREFORE, the School Board of the Steelton-Highspire School District hereby resolves as follows:

1. The District’s Tax Equity Supplement in the amount of \$153,499.07 for 2025-2026 will be held until the 2026-2027 fiscal year and used according to the eGrants plan for the specified purpose of Reducing Debt.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the School Board resolves the allocation of the Tax Equity Supplement for the specified purpose above this 21st day of January, 2026.
