TOP TIPS & TRICKS FOR CARS

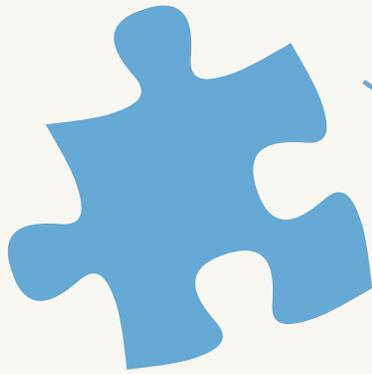


UNDER THE HOOD: BMW
