### TUITION and EXPENSE INFORMATION 2026-2027

#### **DAY STUDENTS**

A **non-refundable** enrollment deposit of \$2,500 is applied toward the student's tuition. Tuition deposit amounts may differ if financial aid is received. Enrollment cannot be guaranteed until the tuition deposit has been paid and a signed enrollment agreement has been received. The tuition below includes lunch, athletic uniforms, on-site athletics, regular health services, most field trips, and classroom activities.

Day parents, particularly in the upper school, should also anticipate incidental charges to a student's accounts throughout the year covering instrument rental and off-site athletic programs. Day parents should also plan to pay for optional expenses such as transportation, after-school care, tutoring, private lessons, payment plan fee, tuition insurance, purchases from the school store, and contributions to the school's Annual Fund. Please contact the Business Office if you have questions about these optional services. The school reserves the right to charge additional fees as necessary.

#### **BOARDING STUDENTS**

A **non-refundable** enrollment deposit of \$20,000 is applied toward the student's tuition. Tuition deposit amounts may differ if financial aid is received. Enrollment cannot be guaranteed until the tuition deposit has been paid and a signed enrollment agreement has been received.

Tuition includes meals, laundry and linen services, dormitory supervision, weekend activities and transportation, athletic activities and uniforms, regular health services, most field trips, and classroom activities.

Boarding parents should anticipate incidental charges to a student's account throughout the year covering such things as selected weekend activities, supplies and allowance, additional linen rental, instrument rental, and off-site athletic programs. Boarding parents may also expect to pay for optional services such as airport transportation, tutoring, English Language Learning (ELL), private lessons, purchases from the school store, contributions to the school's Annual Fund,

payment plan fee, tuition insurance, and health insurance. Please contact the Business Office if you have questions about these optional services. The school reserves the right to charge additional fees as necessary.

## **ALL STUDENTS**

### **HEALTH INSURANCE**

All students must have U.S.-based health insurance coverage. Domestic students must provide proof of insurance with their health forms. International students will automatically be enrolled in the school's health insurance plan on August 15 unless evidence of insurance acceptable to the school is provided with their health forms. Health insurance fees will be added to Student Billing accounts. For domestic boarding students, please check with the school to verify that local service providers accept your carrier.

### **BILLING & PAYMENTS**

All families will have two separate accounts: tuition and incidentals. Student Billing provides tuition management and account services for families, including online account access, tuition and incidental fees invoicing, payment processing, and 24-hour customer service. Tuition and incidentals are payable directly through Student Billing.

### **AGREEMENT BINDING DATE MAY 1**

Enrollment can be canceled before May 1, 2026, by written notification to the director of admission. The enrollment deposit will be forfeited upon notice of cancellation. If enrollment is canceled after May 1, the parent(s) or guardian(s) financially responsible for the student are obligated to pay the total tuition charges.

**PLEASE NOTE:** There will be no refund, proration, or tuition cancellation because of withdrawal, dismissal, or absence during the year.

## Anticipated Incidental Expenses

The Bement School tuition covers program expenses during the school year, including, but not limited to, field trips, on-site athletics, regular health services, and classroom activities. However, some services and expenses incurred during the year fall outside our regular tuition. Some of these services are elective, and all students incur some. Expenses listed below are **estimates only** and will vary according to the needs of each family and the cost of service or program.
