

## **CREDIT RECOVERY SUMMER SCHOOL: Questions & Answers**

### **Q: What happens after I sign up?**

A: You will receive an automatic response saying, “Your response has been submitted.” Accepted students will receive a letter via US Postal service indicating acceptance and assigned course(s) the first week in May.

### **Q: Can I make-up PE credits in summer school?**

A: No. PE can only be done in school or through Concurrent Enrollment. Speak to your counselor for more information.

### **Q: Can I take classes to “get ahead” in Summer School?**

A: No, students can only take classes that they’ve previously taken and have failed or need to improve a grade to be A-G eligible.

### **Q: Do I have to stay the entire 3 weeks of summer school?**

A: No, students can stop attending after they have completed the courses assigned by their high school counselor.

### **Q: Can I continue an Edgenuity course that I did not finish this semester?**

A: No, students CANNOT continue a course started during the school year. Those courses are “Archived”, and students will have to restart the course. Students are highly encouraged to complete the course by May 1, 2025.

### **Q: What is the Attendance Policy during summer school?**

A: Students must attend daily (Mon-Fri), Students will be dropped at the 3<sup>rd</sup> absence.

### **Q: Do I need my computer for summer school?**

A: Yes, the courses are on Edgenuity. Bring your charger and computer.

### **Q: Can I pick which course to start with?**

A: No, your high school counselor will assign credit recovery courses and the order.

### **Q: When is priority registration?**

A: Priority registration ends April 25 at midnight. Freshmen who applied before or after priority deadline will be placed on a waitlist as priority is given to upperclassmen. Freshmen will be called to attend as space allows.
