2026-2027 Kindergarten Registration: We're excited to announce that we're gearing up for kindergarten registration for the 2026-2027 school year! For detailed information on enrollment, please [visit our website](#). Mark your calendars for our **Kindergarten Information Night on Thursday, February 26th, at 6:30 p.m. at Vermont School**. This event is a great opportunity to learn more about our kindergarten program and get your questions answered. Other important events for parents of incoming kindergarten students are included below. We look forward to welcoming our newest Wyoming Cowboys!

- **March 2-4:** In-Person Kindergarten Registration by appointment at WCS Central Office
- **April 11:** Kindergarten Welcome Days from 8:00-12:00 p.m. (by appointment)
- **April 14:** Kindergarten Welcome Days from (by appointment)

2026-2027 K to First Grade Building Placements: If you have a current kindergartner, please look for an important building placement packet in your child's Thursday folder next week. Because our three Primary buildings have a different number of kindergarten classrooms, we must redistribute students as they enter first grade. This ensures that class sizes and student needs are balanced across the entire district.

How are placements decided? When determining your child's school for grades 1-4, we carefully consider several factors, including:

- Siblings: Does the child have a brother or sister already in one of the Primary buildings?
- Geography: Where does the family live?
- Parent Preference: Which building did the parents request?

A full list of placement factors (Board Policy 5113.01) will be included in next week's packet. **All kindergarten families will need to complete the form and return to school by Friday, February 13, 2026.** We will do our best to accommodate your requests while maintaining balanced classrooms for all students. **K to 1st building placement changes will be in Thursday folders on April 9, 2026.**

2026-2027 Building Transfer Requests (Grades 2-4): Families with students entering grades 2, 3 or 4 next year will also receive an **optional** form in their Thursday folders. This form can be completed if you would like us to consider transferring your child from their current building to a different Primary building for the 2026-2027 school year. **If you would like for your child to remain at their current school, you do not need to complete the form.**

From the Nurse's Office: We are seeing a surge in community-wide illnesses such as influenza, covid, stomach viruses, and common cold viruses. Many of these illnesses share similar symptoms, and it can be difficult to know which one your child may have. If your child is not feeling well, we ask that you:

1. Check their temperature before sending your child to school. If they have a temperature of 100.0 °F or higher, please keep them home. Students should be fever-free for 24 hours with no fever-reducing medication (such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen) before returning to school.
2. If NO fever is present, please give medications for stomachache, headache, coughing, or other symptoms before sending them to school.
3. Students MAY NOT bring medication to school and nurses cannot give ANY medications to a student without a signed medication form.
4. If your child is fever-free, but has a stuffy/runny nose or cough, please encourage them to take precautions to limit the spread of germs until they feel better. This includes frequent hand washing or using hand sanitizer, covering their coughs, etc.
5. Students experiencing stomach virus symptoms (with or without fever) should stay home for at least 24 hours following their last episode of vomiting.
