

Ideas for using Paper™ at home

1 Unsure of how to start a conversation with a tutor?

Students' first conversation with a Paper tutor will be a new, but exciting experience! If they are not sure how to begin, they can use these **Student Sentence Starters**. Here they can explore different ways to phrase their questions and get their tutoring session going.

2 Missed assignments due to an absence?

No need to fall behind! Whenever students have to miss school, they can always count on Paper tutors to assist them in completing homework packets or explain concepts they might have missed while being absent.
