Wednesday, February 11, 2026 (Georgia Aquarium)

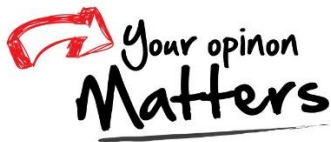
- Forms due with cash - January 29th - during lunch
