PERIODS 1 & 2	Friday, May 8	Regular Bell Schedule – Seniors' Last Day!

Senior finals and gradable experiences will be administered during a regular school day. (No half day or altered bell schedule.) Once a senior has completed a final/gradable experience *or* reaches a class period they have exempted, they are not required to attend that class for the remainder of the semester.

Make-Ups/Recovery*: Monday, May 11th and Tuesday, May 12th are reserved for seniors who are eligible under school guidelines and county policy to complete make-up or recovery work. Eligible make-up and recovery work is the same as underclassmen. **Seniors must notify their teacher(s) in advance and schedule a day to come in to ensure materials are prepared.** Make-ups/recovery must be completed during the regularly scheduled class period (e.g. 3rd period recovery during 3rd period,) unless scheduled otherwise by the teacher. If a senior comes in for scheduled make-ups, they must only be on campus for the class period(s) they are making up work.

Thursday, May 21 is reserved for 9th-11th grade students who are eligible under school guidelines and county policy to complete makeup or recovery work. This is the final opportunity to improve your semester grade. **Students must notify their teacher(s) in advance and schedule a time to ensure materials are prepared.** Teachers will be available from 8:20 AM–12:30 PM.

Eligible Make-Up/Recovery Work:

- Complete a spring final or gradable experience, if you had an excused absence
- Make-up or complete recovery for a **major** grade assigned on or after Thursday, May 7
- Make-up **minor or practice** grades that were due on or after Thursday, May 7. The possible points will be consistent with the PLC's late work policy.
- Students may also select **one missing or failing grade from the major category OR one missing grade from the minor category** prior to May 7th to complete. The highest possible grade will be 75%.
 - Project-based make-up/recovery work is at the discretion of the teacher
 - Per the recovery policy: Majors that have already been recovered cannot be recovered again, and minors cannot be recovered.

Make-Up = An assignment or assessment that currently shows a 0 or missing because it has not yet been submitted or completed. The highest possible score follows the course/PLC late work policy and depends on how late the assignment is.

Recovery = Refers to retaking a major grade that earned between 1–74%. The highest possible score on a recovery attempt is 75%.

AHS Final Exam and Gradable Experience Make-Up Procedure:

- **No final exam or gradable experience may be taken early.**
- Students who will be absent during a final exam or gradable experience must obtain a **BLUE** Pre-Approved Absence Form from the Attendance Office. All instructions and steps must be followed on the form to be considered for approval.
- If a student is absent for a final exam or gradable experience due to an illness, a doctor's note must be provided upon his or her return to obtain permission to make it up.
- If a student is absent for a final exam or gradable experience due to another extenuating circumstance, appropriate documentation must be provided upon his or her return and the student's administrator must approve.
- If a student is absent from a final exam or gradable experience, the teacher will calculate the final grade counting the exam as a zero. Upon make-up of the exam, the teacher will re-calculate the grade and submit a revised grade. Incompletes will not be given.
- If you are approved to make up a **final exam**, please email talelek@fultonschools.org to schedule it when you return to school in August. You can also schedule the make-up with your teacher on the Make-Up/Recovery Day.
- If you are approved to make up a **gradable experience**, please email your teacher to schedule it when you return to school in August or on the Make-Up/Recovery Day.
