High School

In the High School, parents are invited to attend **IN-PERSON** conferences ONLY on the evening of **Thursday, Feb. 12th between 4:30-7:30 PM and Friday, Feb. 13th between 8:00-11:30 AM**. Middle School

In the Middle School, parents are invited to attend **IN-PERSON** conferences ONLY on the evening of **Thursday, Feb. 12th between 4:30-7:30 PM and Friday, Feb. 13th between 8:00-11:30 AM**. 6th, 7th, and 8th grade level teachers, as well as special area teachers, will be available in their classrooms; conferences will be 10 minutes in length. There is no sign-up procedure for this.

Elementary School

In the Elementary School, parents are invited to attend **IN-PERSON** conferences ONLY on the evening of **Thursday, Feb. 12th between 4:30-7:30 PM and Friday, Feb. 13th between 8:00-11:30 AM**.
