

Artist-in-Residence Program

Mrs. Carla Long will be providing the 4th grade students with an immersive experience that has been generously funded by Cultural Alliance of York and the Canner Foundation. Students will be exploring objects through the lens of photography. Over the course of the 10-day residency, she will guide the young artists in using photography as a tool to uncover new perspectives and capture the essence of discovery using the question, "what are you curious about?" This residency delves into the technical aspects of photography along with the creative process, encouraging artists to find inspiration in the world around them. The final showcase will take place in the form of an Art exhibit that will be open to the school community at UAIS on September 15th at 6:30pm."

Happening Soon

Welcome to a new school year! I will start the Pennsylvania mandated school health screenings this month. Height, weight, and vision will be screened. In fourth through sixth grade, hearing is mandated to be screened only in special circumstances.

ATTENTION SIXTH GRADE PARENTS- Pennsylvania school health law requires every student in sixth grade to receive a physical. Please have your child turn in any paperwork from their physical to me. Before starting seventh grade, your child is also required to have a Tdap and

meningococcal conjugate (MCV) vaccine. Unless the school nurse has an exemption form on file for your child, these vaccines are required for seventh grade. Please contact me if you have any questions. Thank you, Jenna Landis, RN, BSN, CSN - UAIS School Nurse
