Dear Central Greene Families,

The weather outlook for the near future predicts extremely cold temperatures, with the potential for additional snow that could further disrupt the school schedule. Families are encouraged to plan ahead and make alternate childcare arrangements in the event of a closure or delay.

The District used its fifth and final Flexible Instructional Day on Tuesday, January 27, 2026. The closure of school on Wednesday, January 28, 2026, was designated as a traditional snow day, with no remote instruction and no make-up time required. While additional instructional minutes have been built into the school year, this time is not unlimited. Moving forward, any additional school closures may require the use of the following designated make-up days:

- February 16, 2026 – President’s Day
- March 9, 2026 – Teacher In-Service Day
- March 23, 2026 – Records Day
- April 2 and/or April 6, 2026 – Spring Break

The District may also consider keeping schools open during periods of extreme cold that may have resulted in closures in the past. This approach allows us to provide students with a warm, safe environment, continued instruction, and access to breakfast and lunch. Families who feel conditions are unsafe for their child(ren) may keep them home and submit an excuse.

In addition, if school is closed on Thursday, January 29, and/or Friday, January 30, breakfast and lunch will be provided for pickup on Thursday, January 29 for both days. Pickup time will from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at the following locations:

- Washington Township Municipal Building
- Waynesburg Central Junior/Senior High School
- Perry Township Fire Hall
