Expository Reading and Writing Curriculum

## What is it?

ERWC is a 12th-grade English class that meets A-G graduation requirements. Students in ERWC read informational texts as well as novels to develop their reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills.

## Who should take ERWC?

Any incoming senior is eligible to enroll in ERWC! This class is great for students who like to think about and debate real-world issues. The CSU system also uses ERWC to place students in English classes, so completion of the course can save time and money in college.
