Our goal is for every camper to have a fun, memorable and safe experience. Please use the list below to prepare your camper to be Summer Encounters Ready! To safely attend Summer Encounters, campers must:

- Be able to clearly communicate their first and last name on the first day of camp.
- Remain with their camp group and follow adult directions during transitions across campus
- Independently use the restroom, including washing hands and adjusting clothing.
- Participate in carline, which includes:
 - Getting into and out of a car with minimal help
 - Listen for their name, and remain at their carline station on the sidewalk, never leaving the area without permission
- Treat campers, counselors, instructors, and camp property with respect and kindness
- Adhere to the Summer Encounters Behavior Policy.

If a camper is unable to meet these expectations or their behavior creates an unsafe environment for themselves or others, Summer Encounters staff may contact a parent/guardian for early pickup. Continued unsafe behavior may result in dismissal from Summer Encounters.
