RESOLUTION NO. 26-01
INTERNATIONAL HOLOCAUST REMEMBRANCE DAY

WHEREAS, the United Nations designated January 27th as International Holocaust Remembrance Day (A/RES/60/7) to commemorate the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau, marking the liberation of the largest Nazi death camp.

WHEREAS, the Holocaust, the systematic, state-sponsored genocide by Nazi Germany, resulted in the murder of six million Jews and millions of others, serving as a permanent warning against hatred, bigotry, and prejudice.

WHEREAS, there is a concerning rise in antisemitism, Holocaust denial, and distorted historical narratives, necessitating renewed commitment to education and awareness.

WHEREAS, state and local governments are called upon to strengthen education on Jewish history, antisemitism, and the Holocaust to counter hate-fueled violence.

WHEREAS, it is our collective responsibility to honor the memory of victims, survivors, and rescuers, and to ensure such atrocities never recur.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: To officially recognize and observe January 27, 2026, as International Holocaust Remembrance Day.

To reaffirm our commitment to educating future generations about the Holocaust, its lessons, and the dangers of hatred and prejudice.

To support initiatives that combat antisemitism, intolerance, and hate speech globally.

To honor the memory of the victims, the resilience of survivors, and the courage of rescuers.

To reject all forms of Holocaust denial and distortion, promoting accurate historical understanding.

To encourage collaboration between educational institutions, community organizations, and government bodies to develop impactful remembrance programs.
