Discussion Item: Review SGC Website Audit

A. Mrs. Alhadeff and Mrs. Strickland shared that we passed the audit in all areas.

Discussion Item: Superintendent Advisory Council Update

A. Mrs. Nelson did not attend the Council, and Ms. Cromer is not in attendance at this meeting, so this item was tabled for the next SGC meeting.

Discussion Item: Council Initiatives and Design Thinking

A. Mrs. Alhadeff and Mrs. Tompkins shared the attendance incentive available for students at Hootie's Holiday Feast on December 11th. Students who have no absences from November 3rd to December 5th will receive a postcard announcing their achievement. They can then bring the

postcard to the event and spin a wheel to win a prize. Mrs. Alhadeff shared details from the most recent data, revealing significant improvement in student attendance overall. On average, students miss less than 2 days of school per year.

Discussion Item: Strategic Action Plan Update

A. The goal for employee retention is 98.6%, and we are currently at 98 or 99. Based on feedback gathered from My Voice surveys, teachers desired more collaborative planning days, and this request has now been granted.

B. SEC Math goal is to raise proficiency from 10.6% to 16.6%. Current data demonstrates significant progress toward that goal.

Informational Item: Principals Update

A. Mrs. Alhadeff shared that the volunteer day with Milton High School was a success.

B. The school made approximately \$9000 at the book fair.

C. Thanksgiving Feasts was a well-attended success.

D. The school social workers from Vickery Mill and Esther Jackson identified families most in need due to the lack of SNAP benefits and partnered with the Home Church Food pantry located in Vickery Mill, supplied by Atlanta Community Food Bank. Families either picked up food, or it was delivered to them. This system will continue as needed in the future.

E. Hootie's Holiday Feast is on December 11th.
