



# LAKE ORION LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

## SCOPE

The Lake Orion Lions are part of Lions International and our main focus is supporting those with vision and/or hearing impairments. The Lake Orion Lions Club has established a scholarship program for deserving students in the Lake Orion School District. As a community service organization, we feel this is a good way to assist students as they enter their first year of college. Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded and are renewable for up to 3 more years, as long as recipients are full time and maintain a grade point of 2.5.

## CRITERIA

The following guidelines are to be used by applicants:

- Senior student at Lake Orion High School
- Resident of the boundaries of the Lake Orion School District
- Documented grade point of 2.5 or better
- Official documentation of 20 or more community service hours, including those in excess to the school requirements
- Student must attend a Michigan college or Michigan trade school

## APPLICATION PROCESS

**Please mail the following to Lake Orion Lions Club, P.O. Box 255, Lake Orion, MI 48361 by Tuesday, April 14, 2026.**

- A cover sheet including name, address, phone number, and secondary email
- 500 word essay on the importance of community service, what you have learned about community service, as well as how you think community service will affect your future
- A community service hours verification form
- A copy of an acceptance letter to a Michigan college or trade school

## SCHOLARSHIP FUNDING PROCESS

The Lake Orion Lions Club will select 5 finalists and a representative from the Lake Orion High School Counseling Department will select the two recipients of the scholarships.

Checks will be issued jointly to the student and the college or trade school of choice.

The selected students, along with their parents, will be invited to attend a Lake Orion Lions Club dinner, usually held in June, to receive the award.
