The 2025 AP scores reflect a commitment to excellence on the part of the outstanding work of LHS students and faculty. We are proud to report a total increase in the number of test-takers, exams, students with a 3+ score, and the percentage of our total AP students with a 3+ at an all-time high of 96.53%. This is a tribute to the dedication of teachers and students in meeting the requirements of the rigorous curricula. Additionally of note, 10 LHS course-based test

administrations increased their overall mean score from the 2024 test administration, with 14 LHS AP courses increasing the overall number in their testing cohort.

Please note that AP tests are also offered through our participation in VHS (Virtual High School) Coursework, which expands opportunities for our students to take online coursework for courses that are not currently running at LHS. An additional 7 students utilized this option.

The increased participation was a strategic focus for this past school year, accomplished through scheduling, course recommendations, and working individually with students through our guidance department. At LHS, we consistently seek to meet students where they are, but push them to achieve their highest academic pursuits, maximizing their potential. As always at LHS, we encourage all of our students who wish to pursue AP coursework to do so, and maintain our protocol of open enrollment for such courses. Our academic and school culture is exceptional. The increase in the number of students participating, combined with courses maintaining, and, in many cases, exceeding previous course averages is a testament to our Lion Pride.

I would like to thank our teachers and students for their outstanding effort this past year. We look forward to next year's AP test administration, and will be consistently looking to maintain our overall participation and opportunities for AP coursework.
