



White's Tower Elementary School NTI Day Expectations for Students

When the KCSD has an NTI (Non-traditional instruction) day, it is a school day for students. Instruction and assignments will be delivered virtually through Schoology.

1. Log into Schoology or Clever as directed by the teacher.
 - o If having trouble, go to [KCSD Website](#), click "students & families" - click "Technology Logins"
2. Each student will have 1 reading assignment, 1 math assignment, 1 SS/Science assignment and 1 special area assignment (Day 1 will be Art, Day 2 will be PLTW, Day 3 will be Music, Day 4 will be Library, Day 5 will be PE). These assignments will be posted on Schoology or linked on Cleaver.
 - o Select the assignment, read your teacher's directions, and complete the assignment posted.
3. Submit each assignment.

The expectation is that you will complete and submit the assignments on the day they are assigned. If for any reason you are unable to do so, you have seven days to submit your assignment for a grade and be counted toward student participation for attendance purposes.

Tips for a successful NTI day at home:

1. Set your alarm and set a schedule for yourself.
 - a. Plan for short breaks during the day.
2. Find a spot at home where there are limited distractions to complete your work.
 - a. Leave your phone/tablet/switch in a different room.
3. Read directions and assignments carefully before beginning to complete the task.
4. If you are having difficulty with an assignment, after using your tools and resources to help you, send a message to your teacher through Schoology or email and let them know how they can help.
 - a. Move on to work on a different subject while you wait for your teacher's reply.
